



Urination Policy

This policy is intended to ensure public respect and consideration while on the roads and pathways for our safety and to ensure continued access to places like Douro Arena.

If you are someone who feels the need to urinate roadside: Use the public facilities where possible or find a discrete location. It is not appropriate to urinate around places of business or homes. PCC Members must be considerate of other people's property.

The Policy

No rider will urinate in public or within the vicinity of a public or private property prior, during or immediately after a PCC ride unless in a proper facility. Anyone caught urinating common ride locations (E.g. Douro Arena, Millennium Park, Cold Spring School, Church At #6 & 40) will be asked to leave the ride. There is a no tolerance for violation.

If a ride leader asks you to leave for violation and you do not leave you will be reported to discipline committee.

Ride leaders should consider stops at locations with public facilities, however it is permissible for a roadside stop during a ride; keep in mind that riders will likely use the stop to urinate. This is not encouraged but we it does not violate this policy assuming it is NOT in the vicinity of a public area (park, busy road, business, church, or private home). Ideally we stop at different locations each ride.

The Peterborough Cycling Club's Urination Policy is intended to ensure safe and positive interactions through brevity and plain language.
