- Ride leaders: discount memberships, Strava and Zwift accounts, PPE and first aid kits for ride leaders. Decrease from prior years as no ride leader training session held.
- Youth programs were not held this year due to pandemic.
- There are a few remaining expenses not included here for 2020 such as AGM costs and CX supplies and events.

Bank balance is higher than in 2019 as we cut back drastically on spending due to pandemic. We anticipate spending these accumulated funds in 2021 some of which are as follows:

First aid for ride leaders \$3,500, NCCP certified training for key members \$1,600, Harassment and Abuse training (legislation from Sports Canada mandatory by April 2020) ?, Battery generator \$350, Trailer for event and CX \$5,000, Storage Space/Container \$ 2,500, Ride clinic's \$3,500, Seed money for CX O Cup & Youth O Cup, upcoming Expenses for the use of the new Cycle Club App, as well as putting money aside for our 20th anniversary celebrations.
